Update your details

Have new family members living with you? Or changed your mobile number?

Avoid missing out on important news, events or campaigns by keeping your information updated on downtowndubai.ae



Log in to your community portal or Emaar One mobile app and click PROFILE. Use EDIT to revise details. You will receive an OTP for changes on mobile number and email addresses.



Upload new Tenancy Contracts or Emirates ID card by logging in to the community portal. Select RENEWAL from the menu to add new documents.



Ensure mobile numbers and email addresses are the ones you regularly use.



Access cards are linked to Tenancy Contracts. Close to expiry, three email reminders for renewal are sent to avoid card deactivation.



For uploaded documents, limit files names to alphanumeric characters and ensure size is below 2 MB to avoid errors. Preferred formats are pdf, jpeg or png and Google Chrome is the recommended browser.

Service fee quick guide

The community service fee is a homeowner's annual contribution towards expenses that maintain the amenities, landscaping and security of the community.



Why must I pay?

Service fee defaulters impact the ongoing maintenance of the community, administration, common area insurance, management, audit, and expenses required to run the community's common areas.



How can I pay?

- Your community portal, downtowndubai.ae
- Emaar One mobile app
- Community service fee kiosks at your community centre*
- Set up Auto Pay on your community portal
- Cash, card (including Amex), and cheque payments**
- Bank transfer

Things to remember

- Auto Pay must be renewed at the start of every year. It is valid only for a particular year's invoicing period.
- In case of concerns over fees charges on the Mollak system (Noqodi), please pay on the portal or Emaar One mobile app.
- Payment reminders for outstanding fees are sent four days before the due date, one week and two weeks after the due date.
- Defaulters may attract an eventual case at the Rental Dispute Centre. This could slow down processes for Ejari and NOCs for sale of property.

Balcony Etiquette


Your balcony is an extension of your living space and deserves every bit of TLC you give your apartment. Here is a quick reminder to help you and your neighbours ensure a safe and peaceful experience during this season of the great outdoors.



Cigarette butts must not be thrown from windows or balconies. This poses a major risk of injury and is a fire hazard.



Garbage must go down your building chute, not the balcony. Be mindful of passersby and your surroundings.



Your balcony is not a storage space. This is an eye sore to the community and over exposure of sunlight can damage your personal belongings.



DO NOT hang laundry on the railings or walls of your balcony. This affects the aesthetics of your building.



Satellite dishes cannot be installed in balconies. It is against the law and heavy fines from Dubai Municipality will apply.



DO NOT barbecue or smoke sheesha in your balcony. This is a fire hazard.



In case of non-compliance with the Community Rules, offenders will be issued with a Notice of Violation followed by a penalty and local authorities may be involved in the matter.

Nature Of Violation	Remedial Period	Violation Penality (In AED)
Misuse of patios and balconies	3 days	500
Unauthorized exterior attachments	15 days	1000

Hot water savings


With the onset of cooler months, the water heaters at homes across the community will be working overtime. But here are our two cents on bringing down those extra digits in your DEWA bills.



Switch off the heater when not in use and at night. This will reduce your utility bills.




It takes only 20 mins to heat the water for one shower. Switch off heaters after use.



Look out for leaks and dampness in your bathroom and shower areas. This is a classic sign of faulty water heaters. Not only can they spike your bill but is also a hazard.



Be religious about yearly maintenance. A well-maintained water heater does not use much energy.



Getting a new water heater? Opt for a solar or electric heater with a top rating of 5 or 4 stars and approved by the Emirates Authority for Standardization & Metrology (ESMA).

When on an e-scooter...

With the rise in popularity of e-scooters in town, the rate of mishaps has also gone up.


They may be the easiest mode to zoom around in, but here are a few golden rules to follow when using them in your community premises.

- Riders must be 16 years or above.
- Users must wear protective helmets, knee bumpers, and reflective clothing.
- One cannot exceed 20km/hr on an e-scooter and avoid internal roads during peak hours.
- Riders must not carry anything that impacts their balance during the ride.
- Ferrying other people around is not permitted.
- Community traffic rules and road signs apply to e-scooter riders too.
- Reduce speed, stop, and allow pedestrians and strollers to pass first.
- Park e-scooters only in designated parking bays.

Failure to comply with these rules will be treated as a violation of the Federal Traffic Law.









Get a Home Health Check

- Check the smoke detectors: Having a non-operational fire alarm system and smoke detectors is against the law. You can get it checked by a certified and authorized technician.
- No place for dust mites: Arrange a deep cleaning of your home to remove dirt from nooks and corners, especially under sofas and beds.
- Repair cracks and chips: Ceiling and wall cracks larger than 1/2 inch need to be looked at by a professional.

Mini Strawberry Santas

What you will need

1 pint fresh strawberries, hulled1 cup heavy whipping cream1 tablespoon confectioners' sugar1 tablespoon chocolate sprinkles



Let's get cooking

- Slice the tip off each strawberry to make Santa's 'hat'; set aside.
- Beat cream and confectioners' sugar in a bowl until soft peaks form.
 Lift your whisk straight up; the whipped cream will form soft mounds.
- Spoon a large dollop of whipped cream on top of the strawberry base for the 'face' and 'beard'. Set the 'hat' atop the 'face'. Add a dot of whipped cream, using a toothpick, on top of the 'hat' for the 'pom-pom' and 2 dots on the strawberry base for 'buttons'. Place 2 sprinkles on the 'face' for 'eyes'.






