
What Can You Junk For Free?

Junk That Is Chargeable:

Green waste, construction waste, broken wood/glass and sun-damaged items.

Note: General household waste will not be collected.



Pet Protocols for a 'Purrfect' Community

While our community embraces pet-friendly living, it's crucial to adhere to the following guidelines to ensure a harmonious environment for all residents:

- Please clean up after your pets. Dog waste bins and waste bag dispensers are conveniently located throughout the community.
- Keep dogs on a leash in common areas and consider using a short leash during walks.
- Ensure pets are registered with Dubai Municipality and vaccinated according to local regulations.
- All pet owners must register their pets with community security. This includes providing the number of pets per household, vaccination records, and a pet passport. Prompt registration is essential. (Click here to register)

Home Maintenance Checklist

Within this guide, we share a checklist aimed at preserving homes in impeccable condition, thereby guaranteeing both longevity & aesthetic appeal.

Regularly Clean Drainage

Clean drains to prevent blockages caused by debris accumulation, using methods such as drain snakes or flushing with water.

Examine Ceilings and Windows

Promptly repair any damaged or deteriorating windows, roofs, or ceilings. Seal any gaps or cracks around your windows and ceilings using weatherproof sealant or caulking.

Seek Professional Assistance

If you notice significant damage or are unsure how to properly maintain your windows and ceilings, seek assistance from qualified professionals.

Dispose of Waste Properly

Avoid disposing of grease, oil, food scraps, or other non-biodegradable items down the drain.

Safeguard Against Moisture Intrusion

Engage certified professionals to conduct thorough inspections of the apartment.

Ensure Proper Ventilation

Use exhaust fans in bathrooms and kitchens, and open windows when weather permits.

Assess Water Heaters

Regularly assess water heaters for leaks, corrosion, and sediment buildup.

Trim Vegetation

Regularly trim your balcony plants to prevent overgrowth, which can potentially block drainage systems.

Check Air Conditioning Systems

Implement routine servicing and inspection protocols for air conditioning units.

Follow Balcony Etiquette

Abstain from storing bulky items on balconies as they increase fire risks. Do not modify electrical fittings.

Schedule Pest Control

Implement comprehensive pest inspection and control measures to mitigate the influx of pests.

Insure your Unit and Belongings

Secure and keep up with sufficient insurance coverage for both your unit and its contents.

Maintaining Garbage Etiquette

In our residential communities, garbage chutes streamline waste disposal, but they're not immune to misuse. Misplaced items like metal rods or styrofoam containers can lead to blockages and foul odours.

Here's a quick guide to uphold proper etiquette:

- Mind Your Disposal: Avoid tossing items like metal rods or large plastic boxes down the chute. Familiarise yourself with disposal guidelines near the chutes.
- Educate Third Parties: Ensure contractors and house helps understand our disposal rules to prevent inadvertent violations.
- Report Issues: If you spot blockages or violations, report them promptly to management.

Violations may incur penalties, so let's all do our part to keep our spaces clean and functional.
